



General Tip: Using Blackboard Discussion Boards

The Discussion Board is a communication tool that can be used to enhance a Blackboard unit or community site. Conversations are grouped in threads that contain a main posting and all related replies.

The Discussion Board Forum page is the first page accessed when the Discussion Board link is clicked from the Instructor Control Panel.

For Lecturers/Tutors:

Adding a Forum

From Control Panel:

- 1. Click on **Discussion Boards** link in the Content Area section. Click on **Add Forum** button.
- 2. Fill in the **Title** and **Description** fields.
- 3. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click the **Submit** button.

For Students (and Lecturers/Tutors):

Read/Respond to a Thread

- 1. Click on the **Discussion Board** button, or the **Discussion Boards** link in the Communication section.
- 2. Click on the name of the Forum.
- 3. Click on the name of the thread or comment to read.
- 4. Click on the **Reply** button.
- 5. Fill in the Message field.
- 6. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click the **Submit** button.

Create a new Thread

- 1. Click on the **Discussion Board** button, or the **Discussion Boards** link in the Communication section.
- 2. Click on the **Add Thread** button.
- 3. Fill in the **Title** and **Description** fields.
- 4. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click the **Submit** button.

Viewing Options

To view multiple messages on one screen:

1. Click on the **Show Options** tab on the right side of the screen (just above the time/date stamps).





- 2. Click the **Select All** button
- 3. Click the **Collect** button
- 4. Scroll down the page to read all the messages.
