

Sri Lanka

An amazing place to live and to learn



Home to slightly over 20 million people and often referred to as the pearl of the Indian Ocean, Sri Lanka is a friendly, multicultural nation. The country has an excellent education system and offers students the opportunity to complete their ECU degree in Sri Lanka or complete a part of their studies in Sri Lanka with the opportunity to transfer to ECU in Perth or another international university to complete the balance of their degree.

Sri Lanka boasts a wide range of tourist attractions including sandy beaches, rain forests, cultural and historic attractions and unique wildlife. The country has excellent infrastructure with state-of-the-art communication and information technology, reliable public transport and an efficient public and private sector.

English is widely spoken in Sri Lanka and is one of the country's official languages.

Capital of the Central Province of Sri Lanka, Kandy is a popular destination for tourists, and famous for its ancient temples and cultural performances. It is also a good starting point for visitors who wish to see the cultural riches of northern Sri Lanka or explore the hill country to the south. Kandy has a rich history — it was the capital city during the ancient Kings era, and is also home to the Temple of the Tooth Relic, one of the most respected Buddhist temples. Kandy is home to one of the United Nations World Heritage sites, the famed and renowned Temple of the Tooth Relic and the Asgiriya International Cricket Stadium.



This is a popular accommodation option available to overseas students studying in Sri Lanka which provides you with an opportunity to live with a Sri Lankan family, and adapt to the host country's culture and practices faster.

Renting Apartments/Houses

This is also a convenient option with many apartments located within the city of Colombo. These are usually offered on long term basis of one year or more. Most apartments offer decent living with facilities such as 2-3 bedrooms, attached toilets, kitchen, living and study

areas and secure living conditions. Expect to spend \$300 upwards for an apartment excluding meals.

- English test results or other evidence of English competency.
- any relevant employment documents (if applicable).

Attach two copies of passport size photographs of the applicant to the completed application form.

Submit the completed application form to ACBT to the address at the end of the application form.

What happens next?

If your application is successful you will receive a letter of offer explaining the course you have been offered, the fees payable, orientation details and course start dates.

To confirm your place in the course, you must pay a non-refundable

application fee of \$100/=.

Conditions of Enrolment

General

- Students must meet all the conditions and special notes contained in the letter of offer.
- Students must meet the minimum English language and academic course requirements to be offered a place at ACBT.
- Attendance at the orientation/ induction program is compulsory. You must obtain special permission not to attend if you are unable to do so and it will be your responsibility to ensure you collect all of the information made available to students during the orientation.

Fees

- ACBT reviews its course fees annually.
- You must pay all tuition fees by the dates specified in the 'fee payment schedule'. If you do not pay all your tuition fees by the due dates, you will be charged a late payment fee.
- You only need to pay for the number of units you are studying. In other words, if you are only studying two units, that is all you need to pay for in that semester.

Final results will be withheld for any student who has outstanding library fines or overdue library books. ACBT may vary such conditions of enrolment by written notice as deemed necessary to comply with any law, regulation or amendment of the Republic of Sri Lanka.

Refund Policy

- Once an applicant accepts an offer of a place at ACBT and pays the relevant tuition fees, a binding contract has been created between the two parties.
- For refund purposes a course is defined as one semester of study in any program at ACBT.
- Upon request for refunds or change of Student status ACBT is compelled to inform the changes to Department of Immigration.

Changes to Semester Timetable/Unit Selection

- All student enrolment and unit selection is done online through the ACBT student portal.
- You will be advised of the opening and closing dates for enrolment via the portal.

- You can make changes to unit selection within the first two weeks after the semester starts, as long as there are places available in the relevant unit.

You must make any changes to your unit selection via the ACBT student portal.

General Conditions

You are expected to attend a minimum of 90 percent of all classes and undertake all tests and examinations for each course you are enrolled in.


